Message:

(Setting the Stage)

Some speculate this moment of tranquility is coming to a close here in America, and indeed we see the fracturing and even the crumbling all around us. In fact, congratulations Memphis, two years ago you were titled the most dangerous city in America.

Aren't you glad you're not living in Ukraine, North Korea, Gaza or Israel?

Well, that's the geopolitical situation but how about the more personal world. What's going on in your life?

I'm certain you're feeling the sting of higher everything. I love to eat organic butter on my toast, but I can't pay \$9.00 per pound for it. I might have to get creative and use tahini, or olive oil or something. Hopefully I won't have to get real creative and make ground up, lightly salted cockroach paste.

(Digging deeper)

At this time of year we often read the prophecies concerning the coming of Messiah Jesus. According to Isaiah 9:6 one of His names is "Prince of Peace". When the angels announced His birth to the shepherds they mentioned, peace on earth and good will toward men.

Jesus was born two thousand years ago ... where is the peace?

Could it be God had another kind of peace in mind?

One of the things the people of Israel weren't looking for was for God to reveal Himself in the form of three persons. Clearly Jesus is the Son of God. He taught us to pray to our Father whichis in heaven. The Jews had enough trouble with this already. They wanted to kill Jesus because he made "himself equal with God." Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God. (John 5:18)

Now we have another person of the Godhead introduced by

Jesus.READ John 16:1 – 11. (Full text on the screen)

The Holy Spirit was sent to do specific things and one of them is to comfort us. So the peace God intends for us now is both peace with God (we get to call him our Father), and inner peacein the midst of troubles.

No matter the circumstances, if we keep our focus on God, He will insure we can have victory ineverything because His perfect peace sustains us for the battle.

You will keep him in shalom whose mind is stayed on you: because he trusts in you. Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. (Isaiah 26:3)

Do you have questions? Ask God who gives to all liberally. If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. (James 1:5)

Do you have insurmountable problems? I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me. I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. (Philippians 4:13)

Are you weary and feel like giving up? Run the race so as to win the prize. Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain. (I Corinthians 9:24)

In all things keep your focus on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith. He will never leavenor forsake you. Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. (Hebrews 13:5)

So be of good cheer, brothers and sisters. While it may get tough at times, we have the assurance that Jesus will help us through even the most difficult circumstances.

每年的這個時候,我們常常讀到有關彌賽亞耶穌來臨的預言。根據以賽亞書 9:6,祂的 名字之一是「和平之君」。當天使向牧羊人宣布祂的誕生時,他們提到在地上平安歸 與神所喜悅的人。

耶穌兩千多年前已經出生... 但是平安在哪裡?

難道神的心中還有另一種平安嗎?

有一件事以色列人並不去尋求的就是神以三個位格的型態顯現自己。很顯然耶穌是神的兒子。祂教導我們向天上的父祈禱。猶太人在這方面已經覺得很厭煩了。他們想殺耶穌,因為他「將自己與神同等」。所以猶太人越發想要殺他;因他不但犯了安息日,並且稱神為他的父,將自己和神當作平等。(約翰福音 5:18)

現在耶穌介紹另一個的神的位格。讀約翰福音 16:1-11。(經文打在屏幕上)

聖靈被差遣去做特定的事情,其中之一就是安慰我們。因此,神希望我們現在所擁有的平安既是與神和好(我們能夠稱祂為我們的父),也是在困境中內心的平安。

無論情況如何,如果我們將注意力集中在神身上,祂會確保我們能夠在一切事情上得勝,因為祂完全的平安會支持我們去爭戰。

你會讓他的心一直緊靠在你身旁:因為他信賴任你。堅心倚賴你的,你必保守他十分平安,因為他倚靠你。(以賽亞書 26:3)

你有問題嗎?求問那位白白賜智慧給眾人的神。你們中間若有缺少智慧的,應當求那 厚賜與眾人、也不斥責人的神,主就必賜給他。(雅各書 1:5)

你有無法克服的問題嗎?靠著那加給我力量的基督,我凡事都能做得到。我靠著那加給我力量的,凡事都能做。(腓立比書 4:13)

你是否感到疲倦並想放棄?繼續奔跑賽程,直到贏得獎賞。豈不知在場上賽跑的都跑, 但得獎賞的只有一人?你們也當這樣跑,好叫你們得著獎賞。(哥林多前書 9:24)
